

Sarnia Community of Practice Meeting – Agenda – September 24, 2015

We hope that you will be able to attend this community of practice meeting – this is the very first meeting of this group to discuss Sarnia air quality, monitoring, and communications.

The Clean Air Advisory Panel will advise on ways to modernize air monitoring in the Sarnia area, focusing on three key action items:

1. To determine options to develop a fully integrated air monitoring network to provide the community with real-time and user-friendly information on air quality. An example is the Hamilton Air Monitoring network (HAMN).
2. To evaluate existing air monitoring capabilities and identify opportunities for improvements or enhancements, including locations, equipment and parameters.
3. To find better ways to communicate ambient and fence-line air quality, as well as air quality following an incident.
